Dear Basketball Player:

Tryouts for the Pony Boys Basketball Traveling Program will take place on Saturday, September 27 and Saturday, October 4, 2008 at the Stillwater Senior High School. Players are expected to attend both try-out sessions. Tryouts for Grade 9 will take place between 5:00 P.M. and 6:00 PM both days. Tryouts for Grades 5 and 6 will take place between 6:00 P.M. and 7:30 P.M. both days. Tryouts for Grades 7 and 8 will take place between 7:30 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. both days. The Registration Fee for the 2008-2009 season, including jersey, will be \$200. In addition, a \$100 deposit is required to ensure parental participation with tournament hosting and concession sales. **You must write two (2) checks.** The \$100 check will only be cashed if parents do not assist with tournament hosting and fundraising. Please make checks payable to PBBBI.

Registration will begin at one-half (1/2) hour before the try-outs, not before. Again we are providing a pre-registration service that will allow parents and players to avoid long lines. Please complete the player information below, updating where necessary, and return it to the address listed below along with two checks in the respective amounts of \$200 and \$100. Please note, all fees must be paid with registration in order to tryout.

Pre-registrations must be received by September 24 in order to be valid, so mail it early. If you cannot attend on September 27, it will be necessary to pre-register, as there will be no registration on October 4, 2008. Please note there is a mandatory parent meeting for all 9th Grade parents at 5:15 on September 27 and a mandatory parent meeting for parents of players in 5th-8th Grades at 7:30 P.M. on September 27. This year all notification regarding tryouts will be via e-mail. For those players who do not make the team, all checks will be destroyed.

Practices for all teams will be held twice a week, primarily on Mondays and Thursdays. Grades 5-8 will play approximately seven tournaments in the GNBL with tournaments taking place on Saturdays. Playing time for Grades 5-8 will be equal time for all players. All players in grades 7-9 must play on their junior high basketball team. Players must live in and attend a school in the Stillwater school district to participate.
